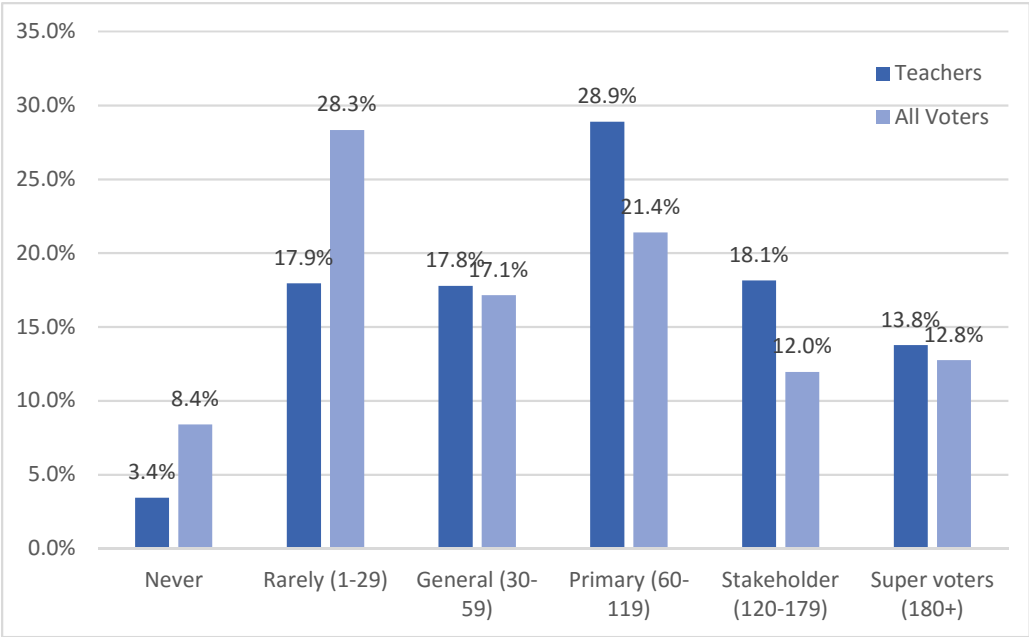

Methodology

SoonerPoll.com submitted a FOIA (Freedom of Information Act) request with the State Department of Education. The timely received list contained more than 94,000 Oklahomans with a teaching certificate in the state. The data was then computer matched, using a proprietary sophisticated 'exact' matching technique, to SoonerPoll's internal database of voters which includes, among other tables of data, a recent table of registered voters from the State Election Board. The 'exact match' requires that both first and last name match using the same address and zip code, and only single or solo name matches made by the computer were accepted. More than 2,000 multiple name matches within the same zip code were made using visual judgement. A total of 58,843 were matched by both processes and the following analysis performed. For universe definition purposes, the term 'teacher' in this analysis is used to describe anyone in the state of Oklahoma with a teaching certificate provided by the Department of Education. This may include recently retired teachers, part-time teachers and superintendents who are required to have a certificate but may not necessarily teach.
