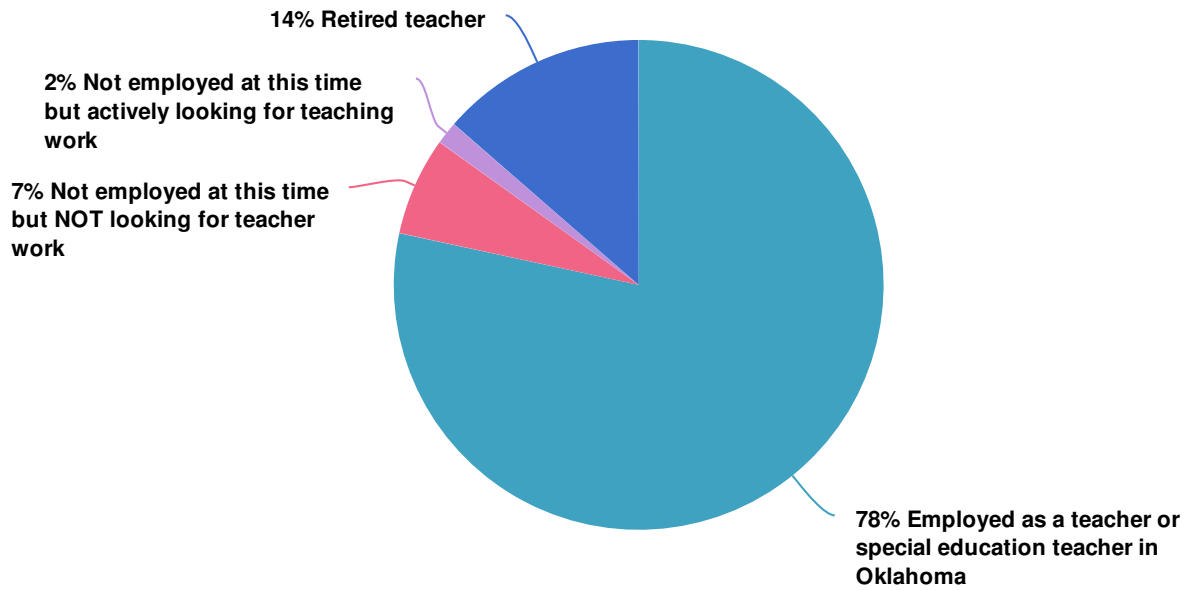

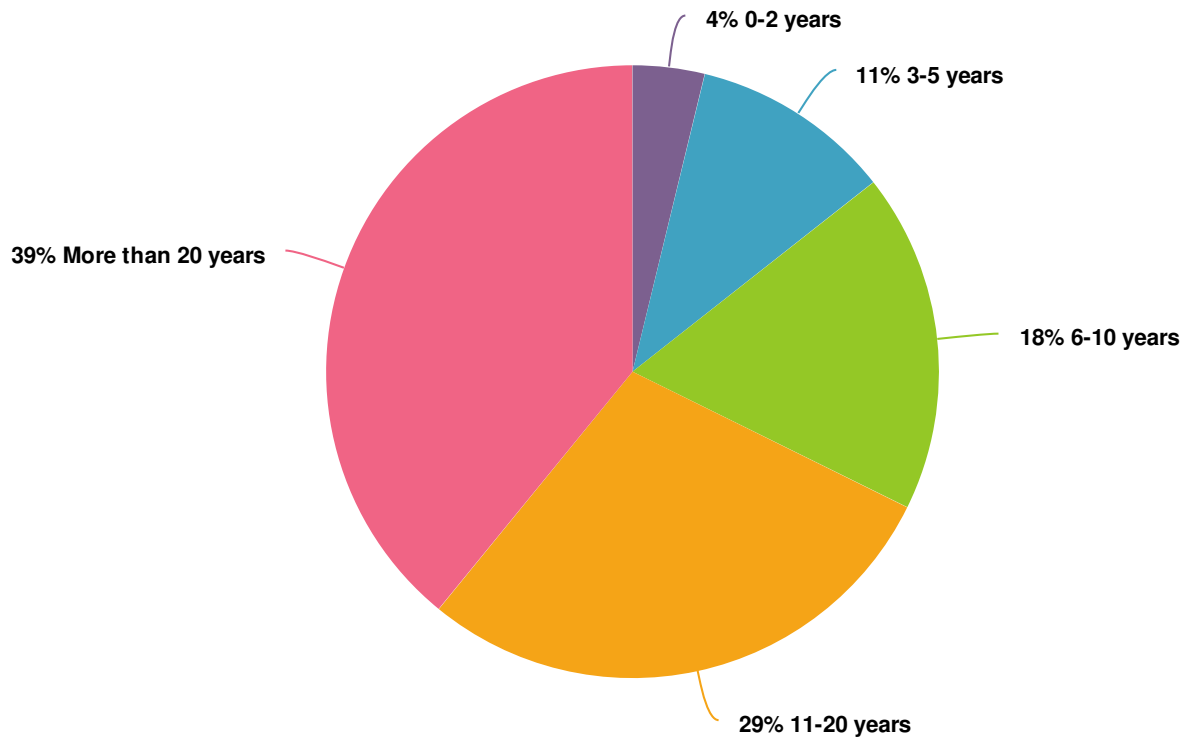

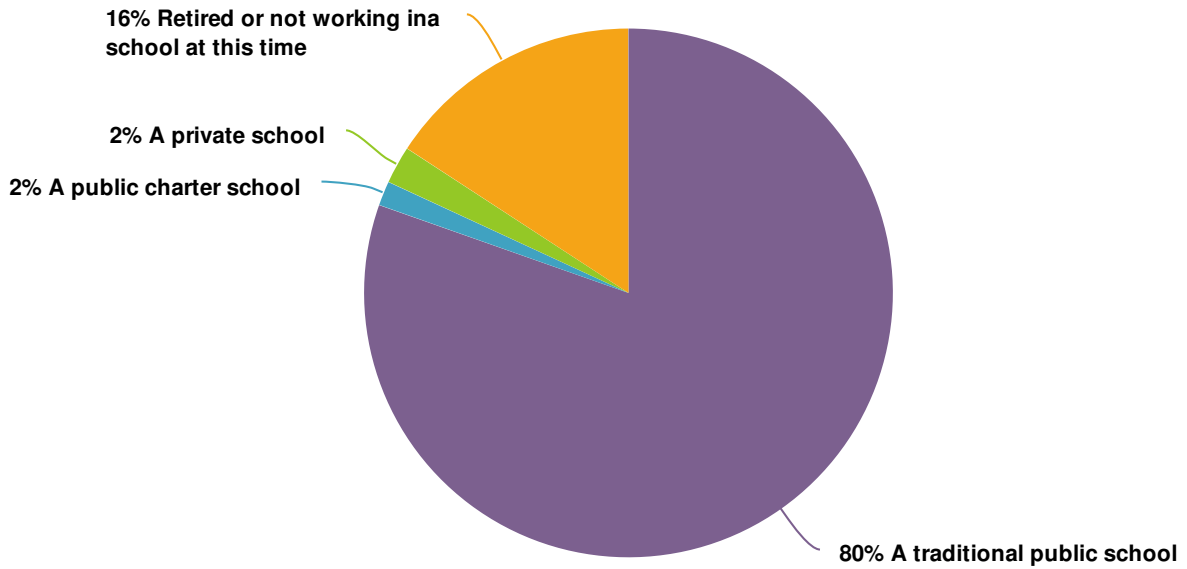
How long have you been teaching in Oklahoma?

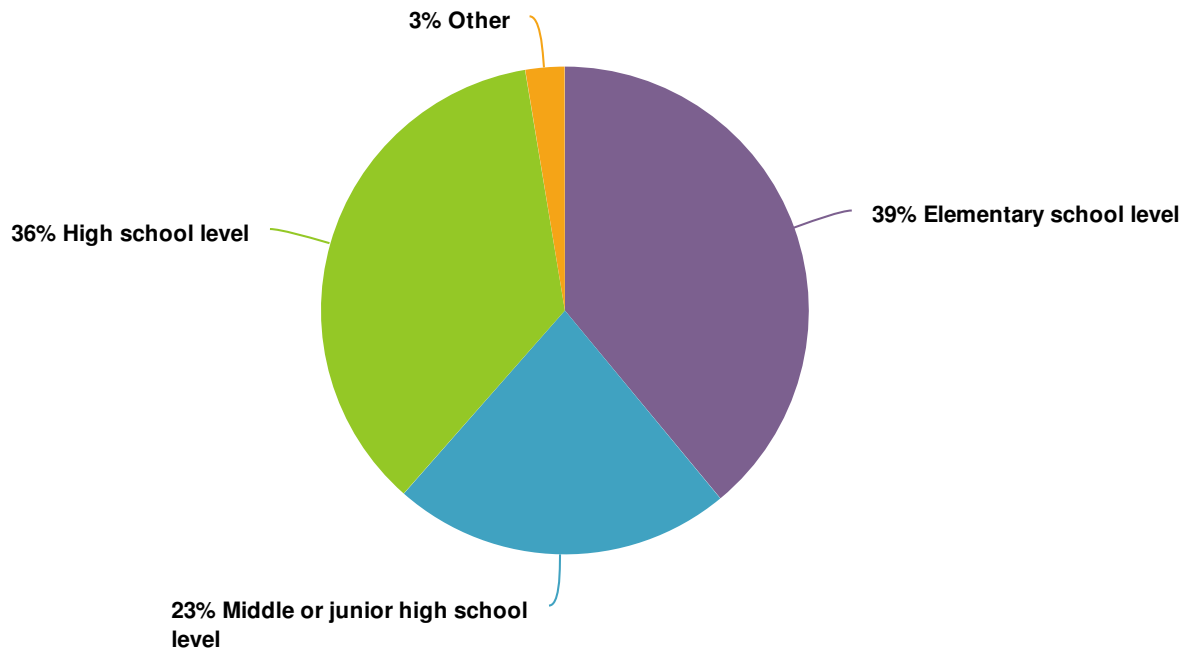

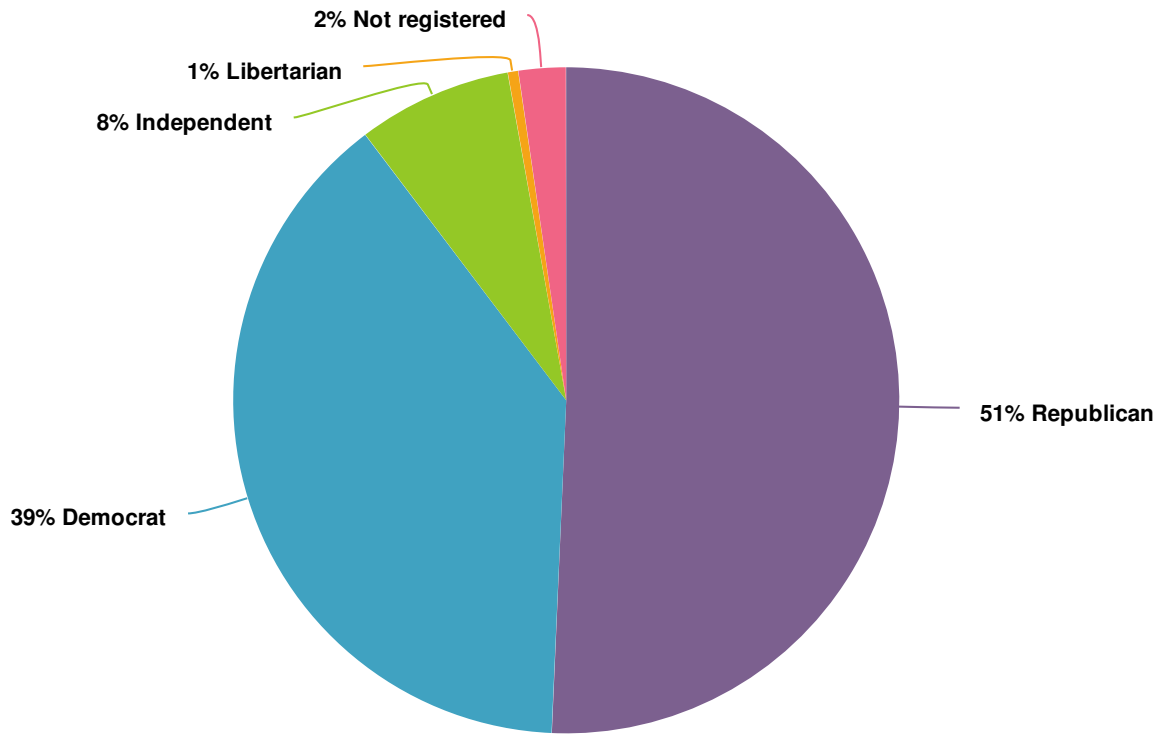

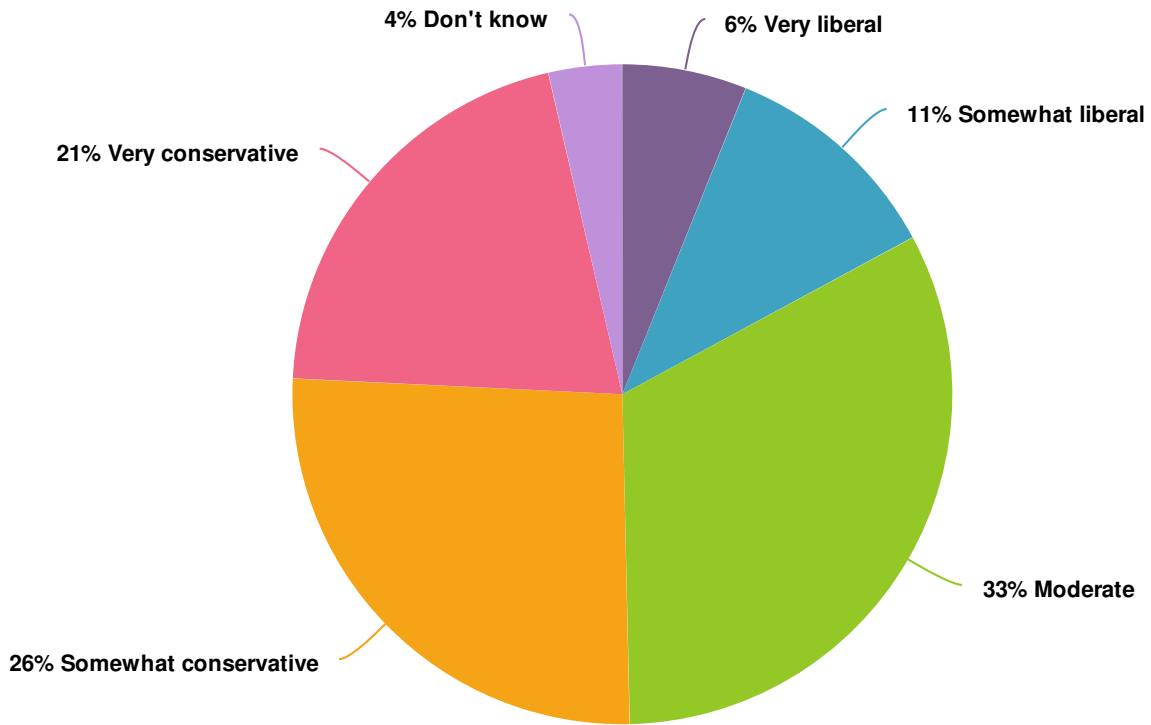
With which political party are you registered?

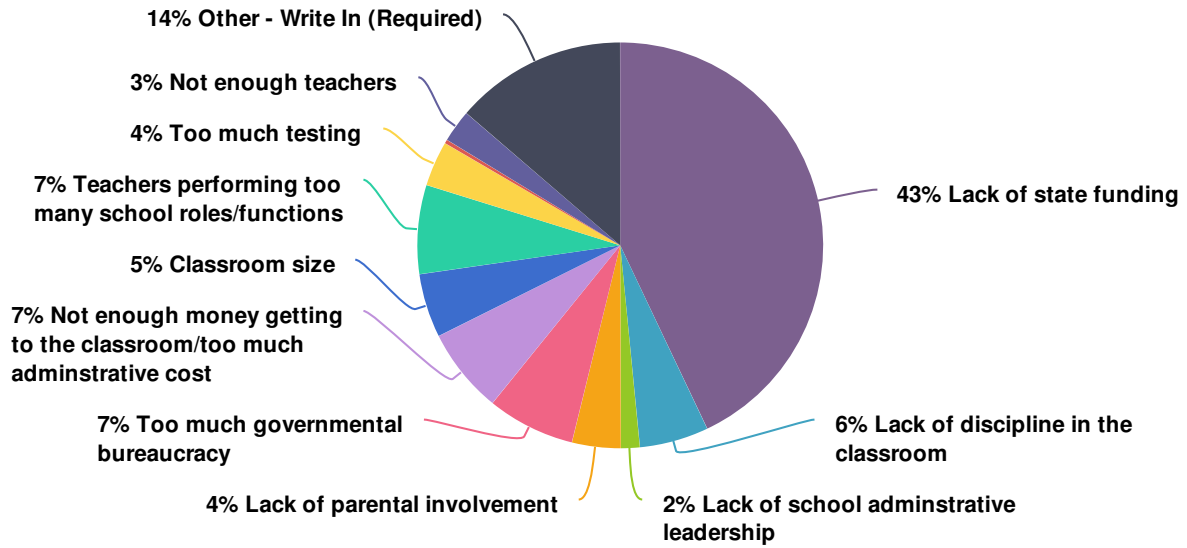
Do you consider yourself a liberal, a moderate, or a conservative in your political beliefs?

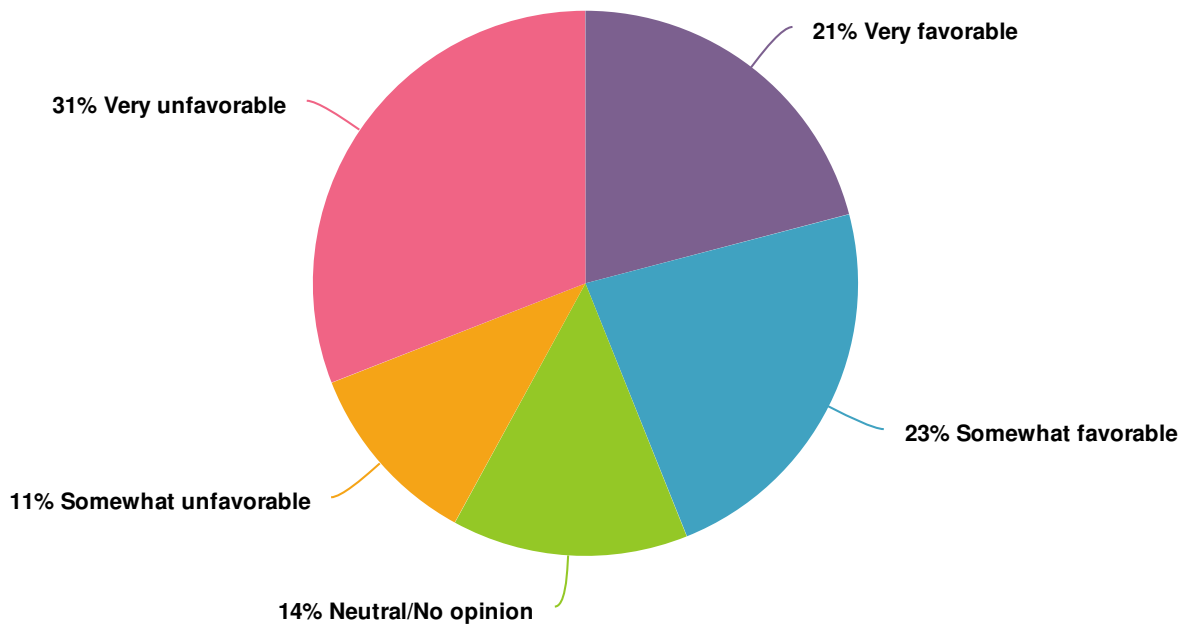
What is the greatest challenge facing public education in Oklahoma today?

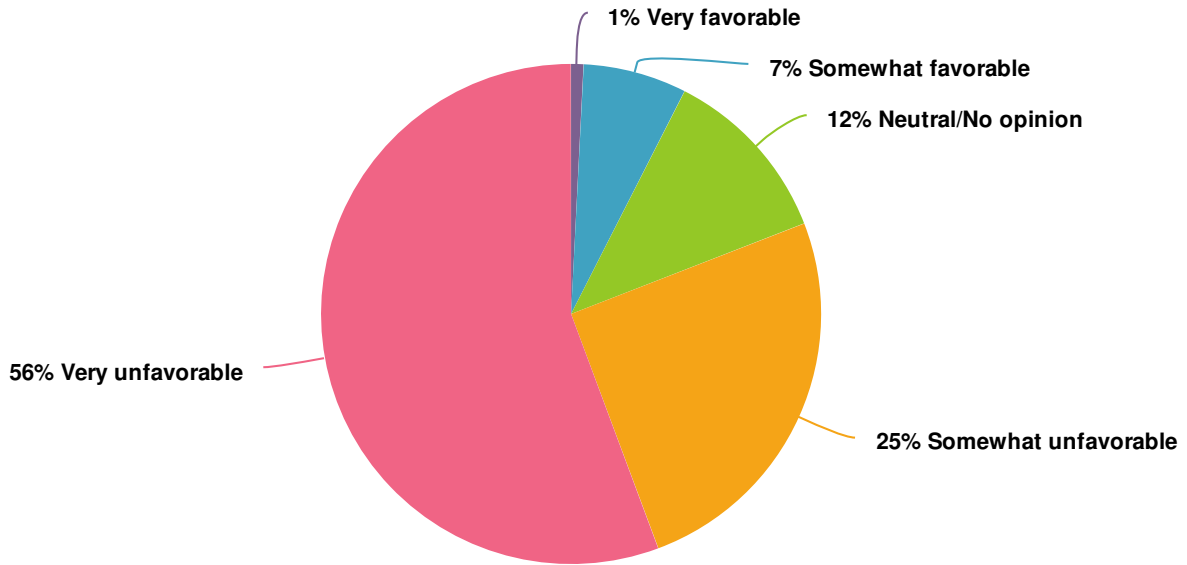

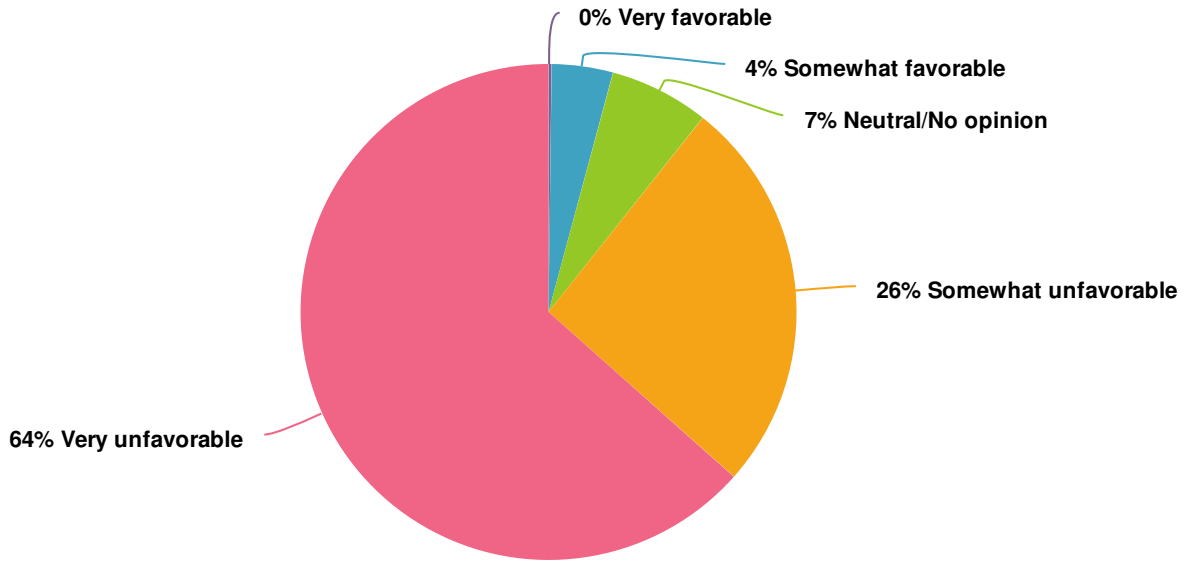

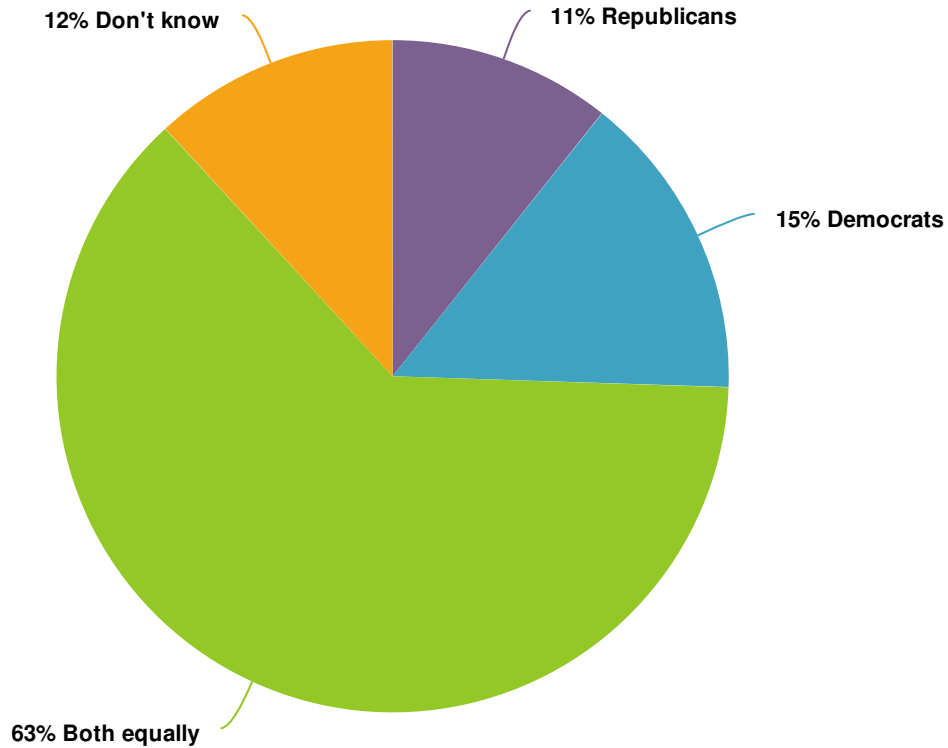
The Oklahoma legislature

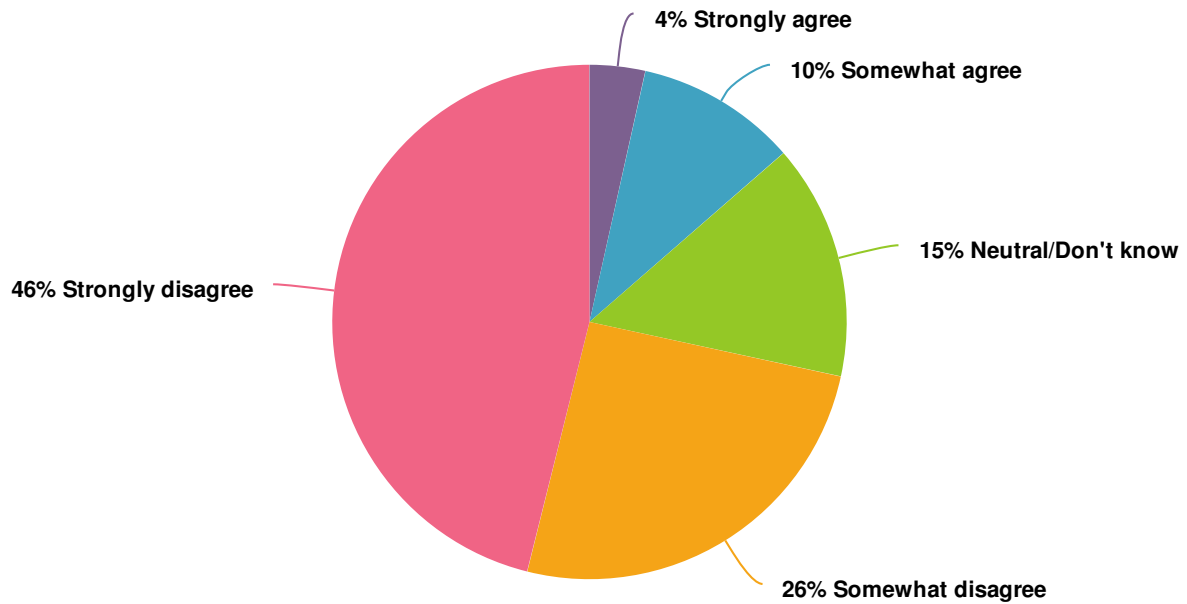

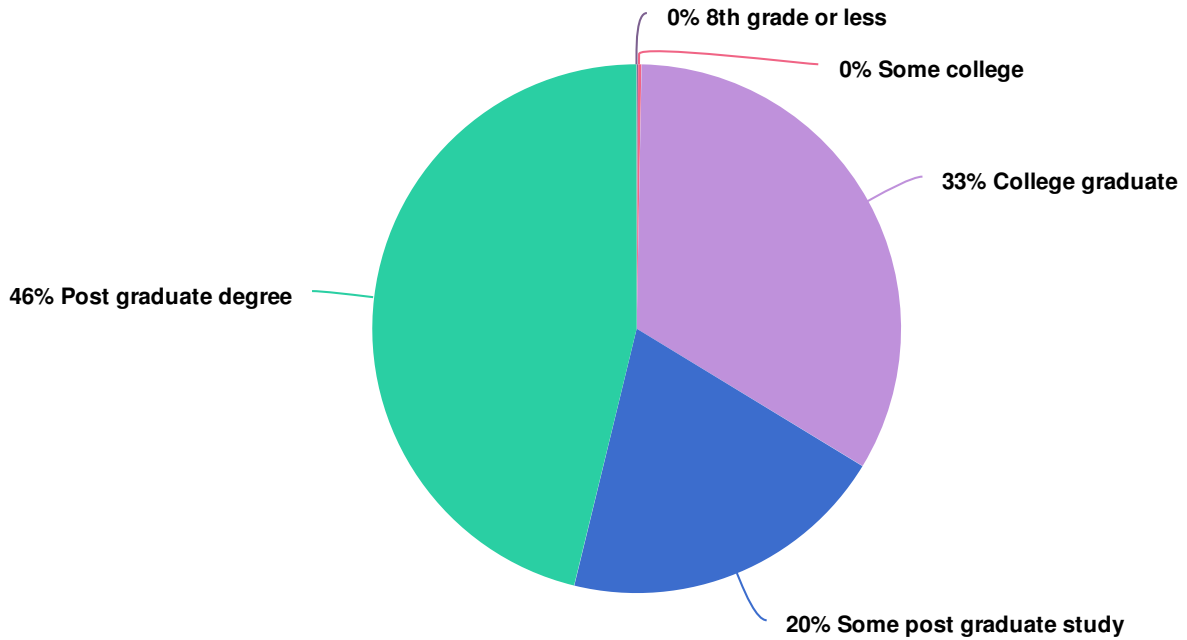
I am treated with respect by my elected officials.

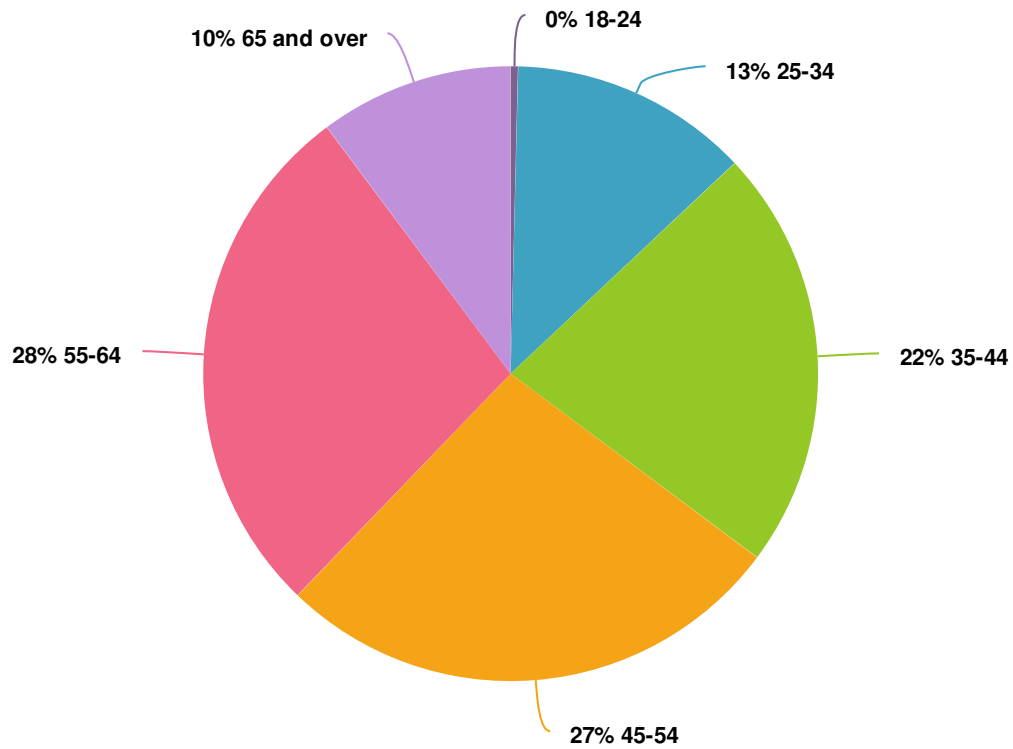
What is the highest level of education you've had the opportunity to complete?

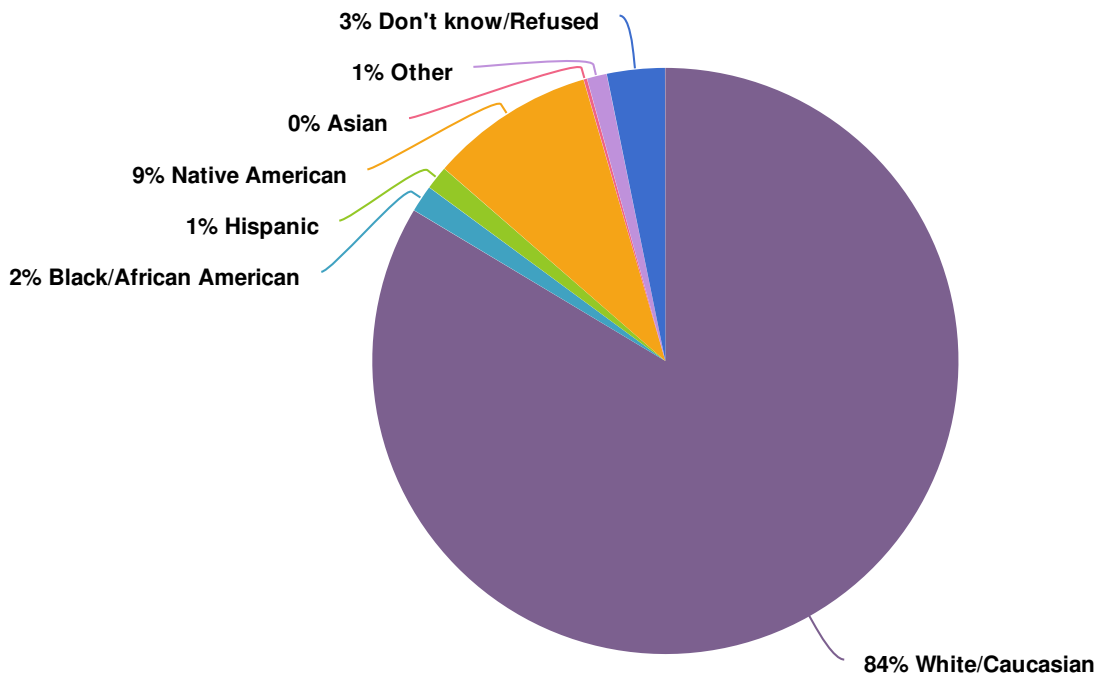
Into which of the following age groups do you fall?

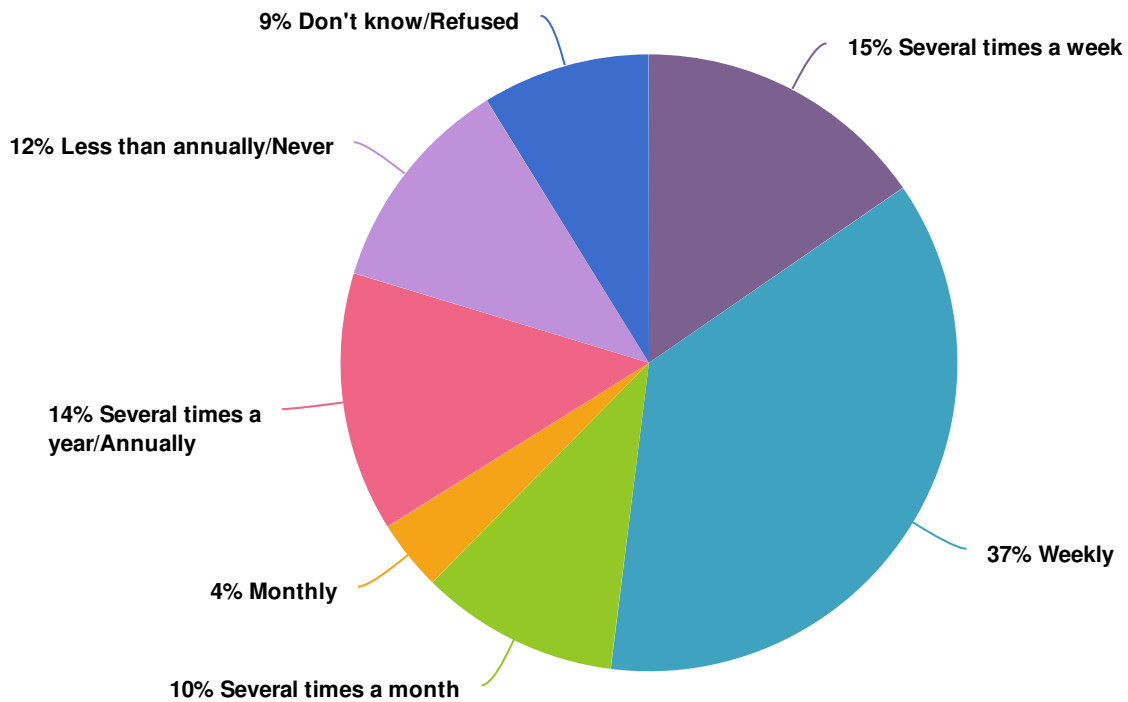
Which of the following best describes your ethnic background?

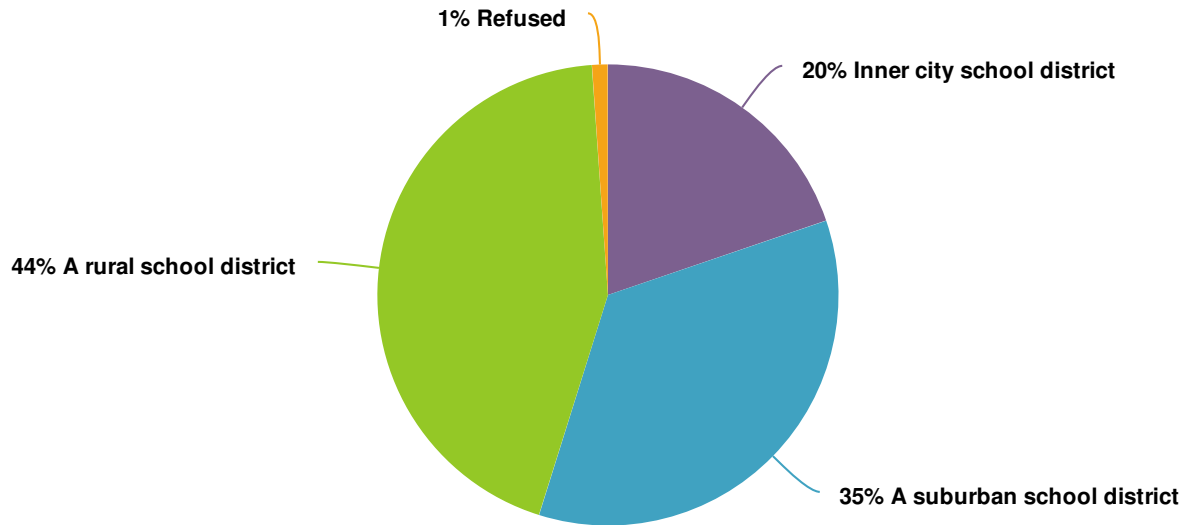
How often do you attend religious services?

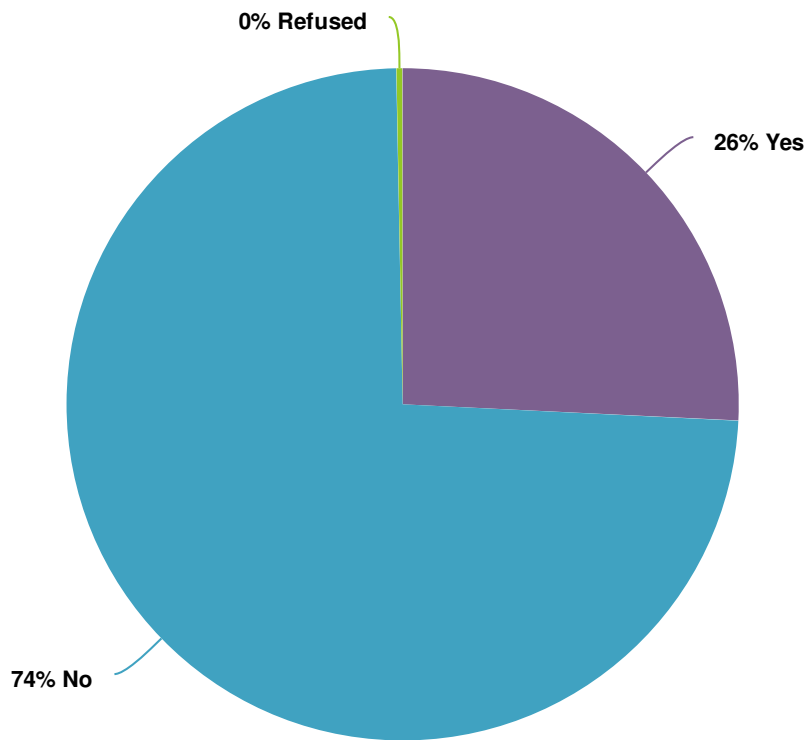

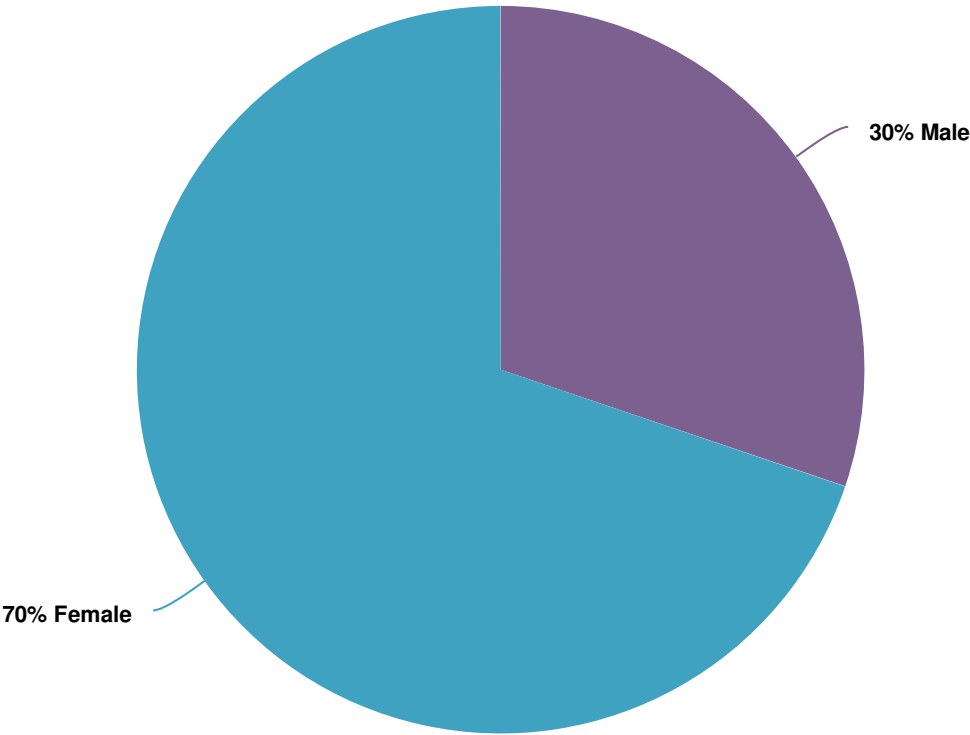
Have you ever taught K-12 in another state?

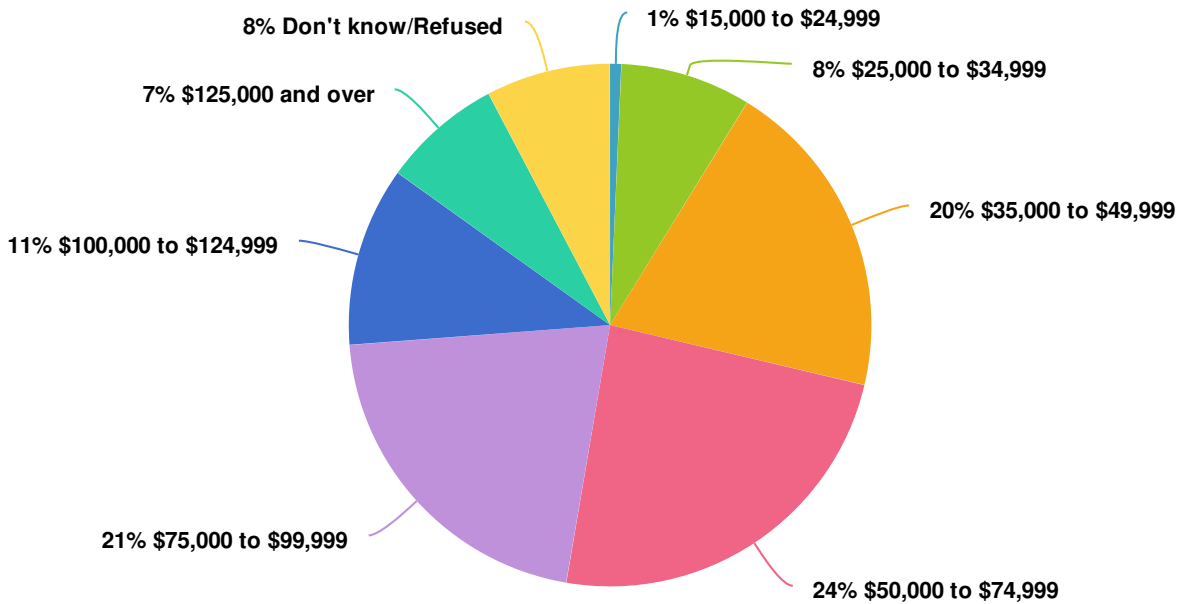
